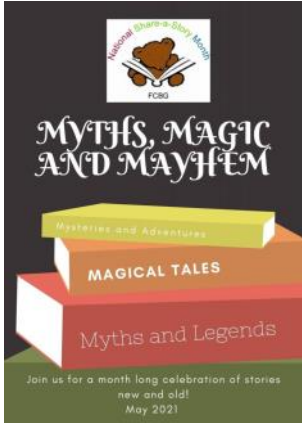

DON'T FORGET ABOUT THE EU SETTLEMENT SCHEME



EU, EEA or Swiss citizens and their family members who lived in the UK by 31st December 2020 need to apply to the **EU Settlement Scheme** to continue living and working in the UK after 30th June 2021. Please make sure that you do this and forward proof of your Settled Status to Careline as soon as possible - those staff who do not will be contacted by the office within the next few months! If you have already obtained Settled Status then please forward this to the office straight away. LEVEL THREE TRAINING ALERT!

For a **limited time**, Careline have access to a range of courses available through a third party training provider for people who are looking to study their **first level three**.
