

NOTICE

Mandatory training for staff supporting people who have learning disabilities and Autism

Since July 2022, all registered Health & Social Care providers have been required to provide training for their staff who support people who have Learning Disabilities and Autism.

This new legal requirement was introduced by the Health & Care Act 2022 and it applies to:

- All services and all settings, not just specialist services for people with Learning Disabilities and Autism, and not just where people live
- All Health & Social Care staff as well as ancillary staff who may have contact with people who have Learning Disabilities and Autism, such as administrative staff.

The new legal requirement does not specify a training package hower following the tragic death of Oliver McGowan, the government has trialled The Oliver McGowan Mandatory Training package and it is the governments preferred and recommended training for Health & Social Care staff to meet the regulation.
