Once you have agreed to go early or you have left the premises it is very difficult for us, after the event, to negotiate a full day's pay.

We encourage all staff to register their DBS on to the government update service. The update service has several benefits for the DBS holder as well as Careline. Registering your DBS on to the update service is quick and easy and costs £13.00 a year, the key benefits include not having to pay for a whole new DBS each year, The DBS also becomes portable meaning it can move between employers and services. For Careline it makes our DBS yearly checks easier and quicker as we are able to log on and do a status check each year.

The Little Welly experience is all about getting kids active, outdoors, running, jumping and of course muddy.
